#### Auscott Scholarship

Applications for the Auscott Education Scholarship close next week on Friday 21 September. Year 12 students who are applying need to deliver their application to the Auscott office at the gin complex.

Auscott support our ex-students attending university by providing a scholarship to one Year 12 student each year. This scholarship is valued at \$11,500 for each year they study at university.

#### Flow Smart Apprenticeships

There are Fitting and Machining and Welder Fabricator apprenticeships available at Flow Smart in Griffith. ### Tocal College

The NSW Department of Primary Industries operates Tocal Ag College, which has a campus at Yanco DPI. They are a training organisation for people completing traineeships in primary industries. At completion, the student is awarded a Cert III or Cert IV in Agriculture.

This is a great career choice for students who wish to leave school and work on a farm. Students who follow through with this traineeship will end up with qualifications and work skills.

At Tocal Campus Paterson, in the Hunter Valley, students can study fulltime. The Tocal Agricultural Production program is delivered under the AHC30116 Certificate III in Agriculture. It is a 1 year, full-time course designed to give students a wide range of practical farm skills and the underpinning knowledge to begin their career in a variety of agricultural industries. Students can start this program at the end of Year 10, 11 or 12. They also offer the Tocal Stock Horse Breeding and Training program which is delivered under the AHC30116 Certificate III in Agriculture qualification. It is a one year full-time course designed to give students a wide range of practical farm skills and the underpinning knowledge to begin their career in a variety of horse industries. Students can start this program at the end of Year 10, 11 or 12.
