It also aims to build students' sense of empowerment and respect for themselves and others.

Guest speaker for HWMHS Awards Presentation

Alan Elliott was a student at Hay WMHS between 1961 and 1965. He completed a BA at ANU and an MA at Monash University. Alan worked for the Australian Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade for 37 years and represented Australia in many countries in Asia, Europe and Africa including: France, Russia, East Germany, Nigeria, Thailand and Bangladesh. He was awarded an Australia Day Medal for services to DFAT in 2008.

Drum Beat Performance

Year 6 students from Hay Public School, Carrathool Public School and St Mary's School presented a drumming performance on Monday to their primary school teachers and their parents. This was the culmination of the four previous Mondays when they visited the school and cooperatively learnt drumming techniques and the performance item.
